PRAYER GUIDE

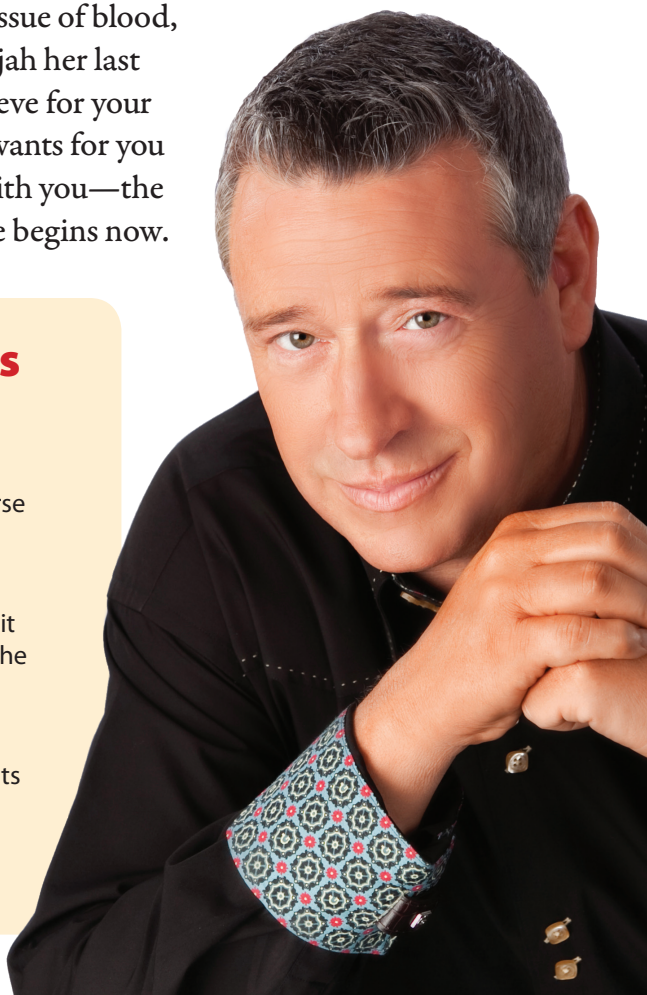


I believe this will be the Week that Changes Everything in your life...starting now!
